Subject: Recommendation for MPH alumni Nepal Earthquake 2015 fund

Dear Arjan,

On behalf of the Nepalese alumni of Faculty of Public Health, we would like to extend our gratitude to the faculty for the kindness, love and generosity bestowed on us during these times of despair in Nepal. The recent high magnitude earthquakes in Nepal have accounted for more than 9000 lives and millions displaced. Most of our alumni have been fortunate to withstand the disaster without much damage. However, few of our alumni have been affected by the earthquake.

After our initial consultation, we have come up with basic criteria to provide support to the affected Nepalese MPH alumni. We recommend MPH office to provide support to the affected alumni with these following criteria:

1. The MPH alumni who have been affected by the earthquake either by injury or loss of family members or property.
2. The MPH alumni who have their permanent place of residence damaged, rendered uninhabitable and now seek shelter in a temporary rented housing conditions.
3. The MPH alumni who are dealing with physical, mental, social and financial suffering brought upon them due to the loss of their homes.
4. The MPH alumni who are in search of help from different sources and are willing to apply for financial support from the alumni fund of the faculty of public health, Mahidol University.

From the preliminary enquiry, we have identified that **Shreejit Shrestha** (2013 alumnus) and **Shreehari Acharya** (2010 alumnus) are the most earthquake affected alumni among us. And we recommend MPH office to provide financial support to these two alumni.

We highly appreciate the initiative of the faculty to set up a separate fund to help the alumni who have been victims of this natural disaster in Nepal. The fund will certainly serve as a seed of motivation and hope. We kindly recommend and request you to support the alumni equally and facilitate them with their rebuilding efforts.






